Gilles de Laval, M. de Re, painting by Elio-Firmin Feron, 1835 Gilles de Rais was born in 1404, in the castle of Machecoul, on the border of the French provinces of Brittany and Anjou, from the marriage of the offspring of the feuding noble families de Rais and de Craon for many years (thus they tried to end this enmity).

Crowley was to deliver this address before the Oxford University Poetry Society on February 3, 1930. The delivery miscarried, and the result is this "tour de force" in Crowley's always incisive and often exasperating wit.
