In response to Jim Crow Era laws and lynchings, African Americans in the South began participating in the Great Migration. African Americans moved to cities and industrial towns in the North and West hoping to escape the de jure segregation of the South.

However, they were unable to elude de facto segregation, which barred African Americans in the North from joining specific unions
